We can use the Present Continuous to talk about actions in the present – now, or around now. We can use the Present Continuous to talk about plans for the future, too.

'I'm Diego,' he says. 'And you're staying in May Wilson's house.' (= action around now)

What are you doing?' she asks him. (= action now)

'I'm not going to the beach tomorrow! (= future plan)

"Dad's working in Dubai for DeepOil for three weeks, and Mom's going with him." (= future plans)

We often use contractions with the verb be when we speak, or in informal writing.
